Job Summary

This position will include taking patients back to exam rooms, gathering medical history, current symptoms, medications, vitals, phlebotomy, lab tests, x-ray, and medication administration. Duties may also include telephone interaction with patients, vendors, and other medical facilities.

Requirements:

Maintain confidentiality regarding patients

Ability to remain cool under pressure
Ability to do phlebotomy, take x-rays, administer medications, both oral and injected, and inhalation therapy
Ability to operate and maintain moderate complex lab
Ability to record patient information accurately and efficiently
Ability to clean, pack and operating sterilization equipment
Occupational medicine testing, including: drug and alcohol screening, DOT and non-DOT physicals, EKG
Home Sleep Study testing
Preparing patient rooms
Checking inventory and requisitioning supplies, putting received supplies away

Compliance with all rules and regulations of clinic and state laws
